

**Resolution No. 26-23**  
**of the Board of Commissioners of Cheltenham Township**

*Whereas,* THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CHELTENHAM TOWNSHIP, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, with immense appreciation and respect, honors **BRAD PRANSKY**, a longtime Cheltenham Township resident, for his eight years of outstanding service as a Commissioner of Cheltenham Township; and

*Whereas,* **BRAD PRANSKY** was sworn in as Commissioner representing Ward 3 on January 4, 2016, and has served as chair of the Building and Zoning Committee and Vice Chair of the Public Safety Committee. In his time as Commissioner, he worked alongside his constituents to address some major issues within the Township, including zoning changes, business development, stormwater management initiatives, and procurement of technological equipment during the 2020 pandemic. He has been a part of important strategic planning efforts for the future of the Township, including the update to the Zoning Ordinance in November 2017 which opened the opportunity for the development of Elkins Estate; the Stormwater Fee Feasibility Study completed in 2021; and the Township's Comprehensive Facility Analysis, which began in 2022.


*Whereas,* **BRAD PRANSKY** was raised in the Township and graduated from Cheltenham High School, followed by Temple University. Since 1983, he has been co-founder and CEO of DBIS, Inc., and Interactive Intelligence, Inc. He is also the Editor of Int2View.com and the Managing Partner supervising Real Estate Holdings for David L. Pransky & Sons.

*Whereas,* **BRAD PRANSKY** has been deeply committed to Cheltenham Township and felt a profound obligation to participate in the process of identifying solutions at the municipal level. While serving on the Township's Economic Development Task Force for 15 years, he formed the Cheltenham Township Community Development Corp., a 501(c)3 non-profit, and was chairman until his election to Commissioner. Mr. Pransky was also a past chair of the Economic Restructuring Committee and was a member of the Cheltenham Township Environmental Advisory Council; the Township's ad-hoc Zoning Revision Committee and the Select Zoning Committee; the 2006 Act 1 School Tax Commission; and the 2005 Comprehensive Plan Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CHELTENHAM TOWNSHIP, duly convened in regular session this twentieth day of December, A.D., 2023, does hereby officially honor and thank **BRAD PRANSKY** for his eight years of faithful and dedicated service as Township Commissioner in Cheltenham and extends its best wishes for his success in all his future endeavors. It is further directed that this Resolution be spread in full upon the minutes of this meeting and that a copy thereof be conveyed to Commissioner Pransky.


