We are contacting you about an upcoming project occurring in Cheltenham Township, Abington Township, Jenkintown Borough, and parts of Philadelphia that will enhance the local electric distribution system. The project is part of a \$58 million infrastructure investment in our region to withstand more frequent and damaging storms, improve reliability by reducing the frequency of outages that cannot be prevented, and support the adoption of clean energy resources such as solar and electric vehicles. We are committed to supporting our customers in their efforts to embrace clean energy and reduce their environmental footprint. To learn more, visit peco.com/pathtoclean.

Our work will occur in the following areas: Jenkintown Borough, McKinley, Wyncote, Cedarbrook, Chelten Hills, Elkins Park, Lynnewood Gardens, LaMott, Melrose Park, Logan, Olney, Oak Lane, West Oak Lane, and East Oak Lane. The map featured in the enclosed fact sheet outlines where work is slated to occur specifically within these areas.

Due to the scale of this project, construction will occur in phases and is expected to last multiple years. Construction is anticipated to begin in early 2024 and is expected to be completed in 2026. We have developed a plan to minimize direct customer impact as much as possible and to complete the project in a safe and timely manner.

As part of this project, we anticipate that tree removals and tree trimming work will be required. Over the next few weeks, qualified PECO contractor Davey Resource Group (DRG) will be in your area surveying the tree work to determine the impact. If there is required tree work on your property, we will contact you directly to review in-person.

We will keep you informed about our work and will update you as the project progresses. Be on the lookout for additional information in the coming months.
