10	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known	
11	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a

13	Section 1303.2 A. Parental and Employe Notification of	<
14	Weapon Incidents. (a) A school entity, nonpublic school or	
15	private school shall notify parents and guardians and school	
16	employes of an incident involving the possession of a weapon on	
17	any school property that constitutes a violation of one of the	
18	<u>following:</u>	
19	(1) Section 1317.2.	
20	(2) 18 Pa.C.S. § 912 (relating to possession of weapon on

- 2 (3) Locally established policies of the school entity's,
- 3 nonpublic school's or private school's governing body relating
- 4 to weapons.
- 5 <u>SECTION 1303.2-A. PARENTAL AND EMPLOYE NOTIFICATION OF</u>
- 6 CERTAIN INCIDENTS. -- (A) A SCHOOL ENTITY, NONPUBLIC SCHOOL OR
- 7 PRIVATE SCHOOL SHALL NOTIFY PARENTS AND GUARDIANS AND SCHOOL
- 8 EMPLOYES OF CERTAIN INCIDENTS INVOLVING:
- 9 (1) THE POSSESSION OF A WEAPON ON ANY SCHOOL PROPERTY THAT
- 10 CONSTITUTES A VIOLATION OF ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 11 <u>(I) SECTION 1317.2.</u>
- 12 (II) 18 PA.C.S. § 912 (RELATING TO POSSESSION OF WEAPON ON
- 13 <u>SCHOOL PROPERTY</u>).
- 14 (III) LOCALLY ESTABLISHED POLICIES OF THE SCHOOL ENTITY'S,
- 15 NONPUBLIC SCHOOL'S OR PRIVATE SCHOOL'S GOVERNING BODY RELATING
- 16 TO WEAPONS.
- 17 (2) A VIOLATION OF A SCHOOL ENTITY'S, NONPUBLIC SCHOOL'S OR
- 18 PRIVATE SCHOOL'S BULLYING POLICY. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS
- 19 PARAGRAPH, THE TERM "BULLYING" SHALL HAVE THE SAME MEANING AS IN
- 20 <u>SECTION 1303.1-A(E).</u>
- 21 (3) AN INCIDENT THAT CONSTITUTES HARASSMENT UNDER 18 PA.C.S.
- 22 § 2709 (RELATING TO HARASSMENT).
- 23 (4) AN INCIDENT THAT INVOLVES SERIOUS BODILY INJURY.
- 24 <u>(5) AN INCIDENT THAT INVOLVES DAMAGE TO SCHOOL PROPERTY.</u>
- 25 (b) The following shall apply:
- 26 (1) Unless the circumstances of the incident necessitate
- 27 otherwise, the notification shall be made in accordance with the
- 28 <u>following:</u>
- 29 (i) The notification required under subsection (a) shall be
- 30 made within twenty-four (24) hours of the incident.

- 1 (ii) The notification shall be made using a method of
- 2 communication likely to reach parents and quardians and school
- 3 employes.
- 4 (2) Except as provided in paragraph (3), if an incident
- 5 <u>involving</u> INVOLVES the possession of a weapon OR DAMAGE TO_

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- 6 SCHOOL PROPERTY AND occurs at a school building, the school
- 7 entity, nonpublic school or private school may limit
- 8 <u>notification to parents and quardians of students enrolled in or</u>
- 9 <u>attending</u>, or school employes assigned to, the school building
- 10 where the incident occurred.
- 11 (3) If the school building at which the incident occurs
- 12 shares a campus with other school buildings, the school entity,
- 13 nonpublic school or private school shall make notification to
- 14 parents and guardians of students enrolled in or attending, or
- 15 school employes assigned to, any building situated on the shared
- 16 <u>campus</u>.
- 17 (4) If an incident involving INVOLVES the possession of a <--
- 18 weapon OR DAMAGE TO SCHOOL PROPERTY AND occurs at a school- <--
- 19 sponsored activity or on a public conveyance providing
- 20 transportation to or from a school or school-sponsored activity,
- 21 the following shall apply:
- 22 (i) The school entity, nonpublic school or private school
- 23 shall ensure that the notification required under this section
- 24 reaches the appropriate population of parents and quardians and
- 25 school employes.
- 26 (ii) A notification is not required if the incident is not
- 27 <u>directly related to the school-sponsored activity or the</u>
- 28 students or staff involved in the activity.
- 29 (5) Subject to 20 U.S.C. § 1232g (relating to family
- 30 educational and privacy rights), a school employe to whom a

- 1 student in possession of a weapon under subsection (a) is
- 2 <u>assigned shall be deemed to be a school official with legitimate</u>
- 3 <u>educational interest in the student, and the school entity,</u>
- 4 <u>nonpublic school or private school shall notify the school</u>
- 5 employe of the student's identity and portion of the student's
- 6 records relating to the incident.
- 7 (6) NOTWITHSTANDING THE REQUIREMENTS IN PARAGRAPH (1), FOR <--
- 8 INCIDENTS UNDER SUBSECTION (A) (2) AND (3), A SCHOOL ENTITY,
- 9 NONPUBLIC SCHOOL OR PRIVATE SCHOOL SHALL NOTIFY THE FOLLOWING:
- 10 <u>(I) SCHOOL EMPLOYES.</u>
- 11 (II) THE PARENTS AND GUARDIANS OF THE STUDENTS INVOLVED IN
- 12 THE INCIDENT.
- 13 (c) Nothing in this section shall be construed to:
- 14 (1) Limit a school entity's, nonpublic school's or private
- 15 school's responsibility to report incidents to local law
- 16 <u>enforcement prior to providing parents and guardians and school</u>
- 17 employes with the notification required under subsection (a).
- 18 (2) In an emergency, supersede or limit a school entity's,
- 19 nonpublic school's or private school's responsibility to follow
- 20 the procedure in its disaster response and emergency
- 21 preparedness plan developed under 35 Pa.C.S. § 7701(q) (relating
- 22 to duties concerning disaster prevention).
- 23 (3) Supersede or preempt any provision of a collective
- 24 bargaining agreement between a school entity, nonpublic school
- 25 or private school and an employe organization.
- 26 (d) Except as required to notify the parent or quardian of a
- 27 <u>student found in possession of a weapon, to provide notice to</u>
- 28 school employes under subsection (b) (5) or as otherwise
- 29 permitted, the school entity's, nonpublic school's or private
- 30 school's notification to parents or quardians or school employes

- 1 under this section shall not contain personally identifiable
- 2 information about a student in compliance with 20 U.S.C. §
- 3 1232a.
- 4 (e) For the purposes of this section, the following words
- 5 <u>and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this</u>
- 6 <u>subsection:</u>
- 7 "Nonpublic school." A nonprofit school, other than a public
- 8 <u>school</u>, within this Commonwealth, in which a resident of this <-
- 9 <u>Commonwealth may legally fulfill the compulsory school</u>
- 10 attendance requirements of this act and that meets the
- 11 applicable requirements of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of
- 12 <u>1964 (Public Law 88-352, 42 U.S.C. § 2000 et seq.).</u>
- 13 "Private school." A private academic school as defined in <--
- 14 section 2 of the act of January 28, 1988 (P.L.24, No.11), known
- 15 as the Private Academic Schools Act.
- 16 "School entity." An area career and technical school,
- 17 charter school, cyber charter school, regional charter school or
- 18 school district or intermediate unit.
- 19 "School property." Any of the following:
- 20 (1) Public school grounds.
- 21 (2) A location where a school-sponsored activity is
- 22 conducted.
- 23 (3) A conveyance providing transportation to a school
- 24 entity, nonpublic school, private school or school-sponsored
- 25 activity.
- 26 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
