Cheltenham School District Community -

I am writing to inform you that Cheltenham School District schools will operate on a Flexible Instruction Day schedule tomorrow, Tuesday, January 27, 2026, due to the impact of the recent winter storm in our area. After consulting with my team, many roads remain unpassable and are likely to refreeze after dusk, making bussing on Tuesday too risky.

School buildings will remain closed and all activities are canceled. Offices will be closed and all staff will work virtually. Our facilities team, which is responsible for snow removal, will receive direction from CSD Director of Facilities and Maintenance Anthony Carter.

Understanding Remote Instruction

A FID is remote learning, combining synchronous (live) and asynchronous (flexible) instruction to ensure continuous and meaningful learning for all students during days when physical school sites must close due to weather.

Remote teaching utilizes a strategic blend of synchronous and asynchronous activities. For clarity, please note the two types of learning activities:

- **Synchronous Learning:** This is live, real-time instruction where students and teachers interact simultaneously. This often takes place via a video conference call.
- **Asynchronous Learning:** This is flexible learning where students complete assignments at their convenience. Content, such as pre-recorded videos, readings, or written activities, is provided for students to engage with outside of live class time.
